Board matters

There were no declarations of interest in respect of the business for the meeting.

The minutes from the Board meeting on the 8th February 2024 were approved.

Operational Items

CEO Report – Paul Fletcher (CEO) reported to the Board on key operational matters facing the organisation, including an update on the ongoing restructuring exercise.

Performance and Finance – Carolyn Bedford (CFO) presented the regular finance and performance reports for the period ending in February 2024, and the Board approved the FY25 budget.

Strategic Items

Cyber – David Carroll (MD-Cyber) updated the Board on progress with PDNS business planning.

Member GiveHub update

Thus far, in this financial year, donations totalling c£142k have been approved for 18 organisations including four grants since the last Board report.

- £10,000 for The Restart Project to fund a digital resource hub to expand their reach and impact, proposed by Damon Hart-Davis of ExNet.
- £10,000 for AbilityNet to fund their ConnectingU program providing tech devices along with training and support to elderly people, proposed by Philip Ronchetti of Netro42.
- £5000 for Upstart Projects, a digital careers training opportunity for young people, proposed by Olivia Wyatt of Cloud Artisans.
- £10,000 for Ashbrook Junior School Parent Association to fund the school's acquisition of 20 iPads to support their pupils, proposed by Oliver Stirling of Cloud Next.
